



Implications for ABB's suppliers


In order to enable ABB to file the Special Disclosure Form (Form SD) and Conflict Minerals Report to the SEC, you as an ABB supplier need to:

- Adhere to our Supplier Code of Conduct
- Respond to our information requests in an accurate, honest and timely manner
- Conduct your own due diligence and engage with your own supply chain on conflict minerals



ABB Supplier Code of Conduct / Compliance standards

1. Comply with the ABB Supplier **Code of Conduct**

ABB's Supplier Code of Conduct has been updated to include requirements specific to conflict minerals:

- "Implement a policy regarding conflict minerals • and exercise due diligence to investigate the source of these minerals"
- Respond in a timely manner to ABB's requests for evidence of your compliance with these requirements"

2. Meeting compliance standards

Work towards ensuring that any conflict minerals contained in the products supplied to ABB do not originate from mines that support or fund conflict within the Democratic Republic of Congo and adjoining countries

- Undertake due diligence efforts
- Establish company management systems
- Identify and assess risks in the supply chain
- Design and implement a strategy to respond to identified risks



3. ABB High Risk Smelters Due Diligence

Work towards ensuring that any conflict minerals contained in the products supplied to ABB do not originate from mines / SOR's:

- That support or fund conflict within the Democratic Republic of Congo and adjoining countries,
- Are in the Conflict Affected and High Risk Areas (CAHRA) and not aligned to the OECD program.

- OFAC Risk

How?

- Undertake due diligence efforts,
- Establish company management systems,
- Identify and assess risks in the supply chain,
- Design and implement a strategy to respond to identified risks.

- You will receive a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) <u>highlighting</u> <u>these SOR's (Smelters and Refiners)</u> as High Risk if present in the CMRT submitted by your company along with any Non-Conformant SOR's.
- Please take necessary actions as mentioned and provide an updated CMRT or a date as to when the action will be completed.

4. CMRT Submission by distributors

ABB Supplier / Distributor (CMRT 1+CMRT 2+CMRT 3+CMRT 4)= Supplier / Distributor CMRT (With your COMPANY NAME) **

ABB will ONLY accept Consolidated (Supplier / Distributor CMRT)

- 1. Please request CMRT's from your suppliers.
- 2. Consolidate all CMRT's into one Company Level CMRT under your Company name and submit to ABB.
- 3. Please NOTE ABB will ONLY accept CMRT's and NOT your policies or any alternate information.

Important : Please update your Company name to the consolidated CMRT being submitted to ABB

5. Respond to ABB's requests for evidence

Initial invitation by ABB to request for completion of the EICC/GeSi Conflict Minerals reporting template (CMRT)

Contacted by ABB if the CMRT is incomplete or additional information is required Contacted by ABB once conflict minerals status is identified to agree on follow-up actions (where necessary)

ABB to work with suppliers on appropriate Corrective Action Plan (CAP) (where necessary)

Submitting CMRT

ABB provides two ways of submitting the CMRT:

- 1) Via email directly to system
- 2) Via upload link directly to system

Important Notes

Instructions to fill CMRT Declaration

- If you are unable to open the CMRT submission link provided in the invite, you can submit your CMRT via email
 @ global-conflictmineralscompliance@abb.com
- ABB only accepts CMRT above version 6.0
- Fill all the mandatory / Yellow fields in the CMRT.
- Only one email address can be provided in the E-mail contact
- Effective date in CMRT should belong to current reporting year (Jan 2022 to current date).
- If answer to question E is "yes, using other format", you are required to mention the format that you use in the comment section.

- If you need product details, send an email. We will reach out to our internal team and provide you the product list if available. Meanwhile we request you to submit a company level CMRT.
- If there is any company name change notify us by sending an email. Meanwhile, provide a CMRT with your current company name.
- If you are not the manufacturer of the products supplied/are a distributors, then upload your manufacturers CMRT using the link provided or share the link with your manufacturers and request them to upload their CMRTs.
- If you are unable to submit the CMRT in the given time frame, advise if the CMRT can be submitted before 15th of April. This will help us to work on action plans if any.
- If you are not the right contact for Conflict minerals in your organization, forward mail to the right contact and notify us.


