

COURSE DESCRIPTION

CHV210 – Rapid Assessment and Recovery of Troubled Projects

Course goal

You shall get the ability to be able to perform rapid assessments of projects in trouble, develop recovery plans and manage the transition to stabilization and get the project back on to the track of success.

Main learning objectives

- Structure and lead the effort to assess project problems rapidly
- Determine the root causes of identified problems
- Develop a recovery plan for any troubled project
- Provide leadership to turn the project around
- Identify and manage signs of trouble early in a project.

Participant profile

Experienced project managers, senior project managers and especially line managers as well as other people involved in project organizations like project business controller and project senior business controller. Participants should have a thorough understanding of scheduling and cost control as well as of risk management, especially of project risk management before attending this course.

Prerequisites

Function according to "Participant profile" and the enthusiasm to participate actively throughout the whole course.

Topics

- Introduction of the assessment methodology
- Planning the assessment
- Conducting the assessment
- Developing the stabilization plan
- Stabilize the project and get it back on the track of success
- Prevent troubled projects
