# The ABB Jürgen Dormann Foundation for Engineering Education

**Origin**

The foundation was set up to honor the achievements of Mr. Jürgen Dormann, the former ABB Chairman and CEO who left the company in 2007.

**The aim**

The foundation provides scholarships to talented engineering students in different parts of the world, for their first academic degree, who can prove a high standard of academic achievement and who need financial support to be able to continue their studies.

**Founded**

The foundation was inaugurated in 2007 in Baden, Switzerland

**Funding**

CHF 20 million

**First scholars**

The first beneficiaries of the scholarship program were three students from AGH University of Science and Technology in Krakow, Poland in 2008.

**Maximum duration of the scholarship**

4–5 years per students (with ABB mentors)

**Total scholarships awarded**

400

**Countries**

The scholars come from a total of 15 universities in Bulgaria, China, Egypt, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Mexico, Poland, South Africa, Switzerland, Turkey and Vietnam.
