Introduction

When having installed Welcome together with the free@home system in a multi-family house with elevator, may be necessary to integrate a respective call button in the free@home control panel. If this condition is met, the user will be able to call/enable the elevator after having rang the doorbell.

Therefore, the control of the elevator system requires an own push-button input. The push-button's function needs to be fixed at 1 sec. Please check in advance if your elevator system meets these requirements.






Fig. 1: Overview diagram



1. When a switch actuator is installed in a room, a function called "Trigger" is displayed in the allocation area:




2. Add the function and the free@home control panel to the floor plan:
