for the following product part numbers: LT38P-QC-X; LT50P-QC-X; LT75P-QC-X; LT100P-QC-X

Replace the "X" in the part number by one of the following: B = black, G = gray,  $LG = light\ gray$ 

- 1. Cut conduit clean and square
- Insert conduit through gland-nut opening and push conduit firmly to bottom with slight twist (Figure 1)
- Tighten gland-nut by hand or with a wrench to bottom on body shoulder (Figure 2)



4. Insert fitting in clearance or threaded hole (Figure 3)
