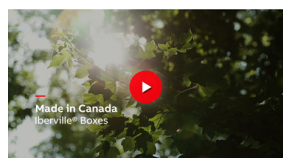

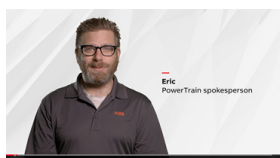

Our ever-popular Marrette® PRO-BLU™ wire connector will be the focus of an upcoming 2022 promotion. Timing has yet to be confirmed.

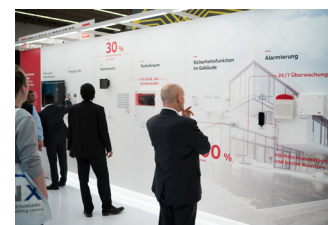
The Ty-Rap® cable tie promotion is set to return in Q2 with a special offer to tempt your customers.
